Gourd farmers selling unwashed gourds will be located in areas outdoors due to health precautions and will pay WSGS 10% (ten percent) of their total sales after the end of the festival.

Gourd farmers selling washed gourds who prefer to be located in a booth indoors will pay WSGS 20% (twenty percent) of their total sales. If these same gourd farmers prefer to be located outdoors, they will pay WSGS 10% of their total sales after the end of the festival. Payment in full to WSGS will be due by July 21, 2010. Spaces/booths for gourd farmers will be assigned on a "first come, first serve" basis.

RV camping, including water, power and on-site dumping facility are available through the Fairgrounds. See website for more details.

Please submit this signed Application/Agreement to the Washington State Gourd Society, c/o Bob Riveira, WSGS Treasurer, at P.O. Box 1468, Marysville, WA 98270-7796. Upon receipt, Dynva Todd will contact you to confirm space selection. **All Applications must be received by June 1, 2010. If space is still available, a \$25 late fee will be added to applications that are accepted after this date.** Payment in full to WSGS will be due by July 21, 2010.
