Applicants whose merchandise is their own personal gourd craft/art will be considered private vendors. Those selling tools, dyes, books, craft-related supplies or gourds from another source must register as commercial vendors. Private Vendor/Exhibitor: \$125 for 10' x 10' space/booth; additional 10' x 10' space/booths \$50 each. Each 10' x 10' space/booth includes one (1) 8' table, two (2) chairs and two (2) admission wristbands.

Commercial Vendor: \$250 for 10' x 10' space/booth; additional 10' x 10' space/booths \$75 each. Each 10' x 10' booth includes one (1) 8' table and two (2) chairs, and two (2) admission wristbands.
